<b>NARRATIVE:</b> The undersigned has probable cause to believe the above-named defendant on the <u>16</u> of <u>May</u> 2018 at <u>0:25</u> at <u>1051 LEE RD #32D</u> (Zone: <u>14</u> ) in Orange County did			
<p>On 05/16/2018, at approximately 0025 hours, I D/S J. Spencer, responded to 1051 Lee Road #32D in reference to a domestic battery. Upon arrival at the resident I could hear the sound of someone banging on a door inside of the residence. I knocked on the door advising "Sheriff's Office!". A male and female both opened the door. They were identified as Kristin Crawford and Edwin Morales. Both parties were separated and I spoke with Ms. Crawford. She advised that she and her boyfriend Edwin live together in their apartment as a family. They have been dating for the past 4 months. She advised that they got into an argument because Mr. Morales likes to joke around and say that he is breaking up with her. She advised he did this tonight and she became upset. She then began to break property inside of the residence. She then advises that why she was breaking an item Mr. Morales walked into the bedroom and punched her in the arm. He continued to yell in her face and that is why she then called 911. She then explained that she was in the bedroom with door closed and he was trying to get in to the room. I asked if that was the banging noise that I originally heard. She stated it was. Ms. Crawford did explain that she struck him in the face but that was because he was continuing to batter her and it was out of self-defense. She refused to press charges or provide a written statement on the incident. She also refused to cooperate with domestic violence paperwork. I spoke with Mr. Morales who informed me that they got into an argument and Ms. Crawford began to break their property inside of the residence. He then explains that he "snapped" and punched her in the arm. I asked if he wanted to press charges or complete a sworn written statement. He advised he did not wish too. He also advised that they are living together as a family in the residence and have been together for 4 years. No one else lives in the residence and they sleep in the same bed together. Through my investigation, I found that Mr. Morales was the primary aggressor in the incident. Edwin Morales did commit the offense of Battery domestic violence which is a violation of F.S.S. 784.03(-7). I placed Mr. Morales under arrest and informed him of the charge against him. He was transported to the Orange County Jail without incident. Ms. Crawford was provided with a victim's rights brochure and a domestic packet was completed in reference to the incident.</p>
