NARRATIVE:		The undersigned has probable cause to believe the above-named defendant on the <u>11</u> of <u>April 2017</u> at <u>0:00</u> at <u>1031 S ORLANDO AVE</u> (Zone: <u>1</u>) in Orange County did	
<p>On April 19, 2017 at approximately 1611 Hours, I responded to the Krispy Kreme establishment located at 1031 South Orlando Avenue in reference to the management requesting a trespass warning to be issued to an employee later identified as Erika Slate.</p> <p>Upon my arrival I met with a Regional Manager identified as Paul Bellanca. While at the scene I observed as Bellanca confronted Slate by showing her the video surveillance footage of her taking money from the back office. Slate admitted that was her on the video, but denied taking all the cash amount that Paul was reporting. While in my presence Slate spontaneously uttered that she took the money, but did not take more than \$500.</p> <p>After watching the video footage and listening to the utterances made by Slate, I decided to further my investigation by conducting and interview. I asked Slate to go outside the store and read her Constitutional Rights form a department issued printed card. Post Miranda, slate provided a verbal and sworn written statement depicting the following:</p> <p>Throughout a few days she took some money from the business. On Easter Sunday she took \$120, but was not sure on the amount of the other two days. Slate stated that in total she did not take over \$500.00. Slate stated the reason she took the money was because she took maternity leave, and fell on hard times. Slate said she has 3 children at home, and knew she should not have done that. Slate stated she took the money in a span of two months.</p> <p>While at the scene I reviewed the video surveillance footage provided by Bellanca. The footage showed the following three instances in which slate took money from the business:</p> <p>04/10/2017 at 0300 hours - The video shows Slate entering the manager's office making change. Bellanca stated that is not standard procedure. After approximately 10 minutes, the surveillance shows Slate concealing the money into her pocket, then leaving the area. Bellanca stated the store safe log was short \$350 on that day.</p> <p>04/11/2017 at 1900 hours- The video shows slate entering the manager's office to make change. Bellanca stated that is not standard procedure, because changed had already been done earlier in the day. After approximately 30 minutes, the surveillance shows Slate concealing money into her pocket, then leaving the area. Bellanca stated the store safe log was short \$200.00 on that day.</p> <p>04/16/2017 at 1816 hours - The video shows Slate entering the manager's office to make change. After approximately 30 minutes, the surveillance footage shows Slate setting money aside on the counter, then concealing the money into her purse. Slate did a "Celebration Dance" and left the area. Bellanca stated the store safe log was short \$700.00 on that day.</p> <p>The total of the reported stolen amount is \$1,250.00.</p> <p>Bellanca stated they suspected her taking money before, and had to install the overhead camera to finally catch her. Bellanca stated that Slate did not have permission to take the money and they wish to press charges.</p> <p>Bellanca provided a copy of the video surveillance footage and I submitted it into the digital evidence (Q-Drive). Bellanca issued a trespass warning to Slate (2017TP001869).</p> <p>Based on the video surveillance and Slate's statements, I determined I had probable cause to believe that Erika Slate (Defendant) knowingly and unlawfully obtained to obtain cash from the Krispy Kreme business (victim). Slate did so with intent to, either temporarily or permanently, deprive Krispy Kreme of their right to the property or any benefit from it. The total combined value was \$1,250.00 a violation of F.S.S. 812.014 (2)(C)(1) Grand Theft.</p>
