NARRATIVE: The undersigned has probable cause to believe the above-named defendant on the 01 of January 2017 at 22:55 at 5200 S JOHN YOUNG PKWY (KFC) (Zone: E6) in Orange County did

On 01/02/2017, at approximately 0957 hours, Officer J. Sanchez (16107) and I, Officer K. Graumann (17022), responded to 4200 S. John Young Pkwy. (Kentucky Fried Chicken) in reference to Aggravated Battery. Upon arrival we met with the victim, Keshay Brisco, and suspect, Jasmine Bridges. We also met with witnesses, night manager Linda Tatoute and day manager Myrtho Pierre. Both Brisco, Bridges, and Tatoute all provided Sworn Written Statements, and Pierre provided a verbal statement.

Based on the statements provided and the evidence obtained, the following occurred:

On 01/01/2017, sometime between approximately 2245 hours and 2257 hours, Brisco and Bridges were engaging in a heated verbal argument. Bridges had clocked out of work at KFC approximately 3 hours prior but had hung around the restaurant arguing with Brisco all night about a man name Levy Simon (NOI). Bridges' manager, Tatoute, had repeatedly told Bridges to go home for the night, and the taxi she had called finally arrived at the restaurant around 2245 hours. Tatoute told Bridges to go to the taxi and leave, but she stayed and continued the argument with Brisco.

As Bridges stepped closer to her, Brisco turned to walk away. Bridges then grabbed a cup of hot water and threw it at Brisco's back. The water hit Brisco in the lower left part of her back and burned her through her work shirt. Tatoute stated Brisco immediately began crying, and she asked Bridges to stay while she called her mother. Bridges instead left the store in the taxi. Tatoute checked Brisco's injury approximately 5 minutes after it occurred, and she confirmed the skin was badly burned and already peeling off. Tatoute and Brisco both stated the water Bridges had thrown was a cup of water Brisco had prepped for cleaning of the kitchen, and it was approximately 212 degrees. It should also be noted another store employee, Shalynn "Shay" Jones witnessed the incident and injury, but she could not be contacted to provide a statement.

Brisco stated she initially returned home to take care of her injury and planned to call police the next day, since Bridges had already left the scene. Brisco stated no one had permission to throw hot water at her, and she wishes to press charges. Sergeant T. Braunschwill (14638) responded to the scene to photograph Brisco's injury, which appeared still pink as well as white in some areas where skin was missing.

It should be noted Bridges returned to the scene under her own power, and she cooperated with police throughout the investigation. She spontaneously admitted to throwing the water in Brisco's direction, but she stated she felt threatened because Brisco had threatened her infant daughter by saying, "you need to be worried about your mother-fucking baby." She stated the cup of water was small, and she did not think it even hit Brisco's shirt. Brisco denied making any statements about Bridge's child, and witnesses could not confirm any threats made.

Pierre, who was not present during the actual incident, showed us the store's video surveillance footage captured during the incident. In the footage Bridges can be seen following Brisco around the store, and the two can be seen mutually arguing. At the moment Bridges threw the water both subjects were out of camera view; but Brisco could be seen quickly returning into view while holding her left lower back with her hand. Bridges then quickly left the store.

Based on the statements provided and the evidence and injury observed, probable cause exists to charge Jasmine Bridges with Aggravated Battery. She was arrested and transported to jail without incident.
